About HortiFresh

HortiFresh is a programme supported by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands which has prioritized commercial agriculture in its strategic plan of moving from aid to trade. The programme's mission is to establish "a sustainable and internationally competitive fruit and vegetable sector that contributes to inclusive economic growth, food and nutrition security" in Ghana and Ivory Coast.



The programme consists of two components: fruits and vegetables. In Ghana, attention is being given to the fruit and vegetable sectors while focusing on other regional fruit supply chain dimensions in Ivory Coast.

The objectives include improving productivity in the vegetable sector; facilitating more efficient markets, including linking vegetable producers and other value chain operators with the Dutch private sector; improving the business climate and further professionalizing the value chain for production and consumption in West Africa.

The programme runs until 2021 and aims to reach 15,000 farmers with 20% increase in productivity, increase turnovers and export volumes of businesses supported by 25%.

HortiFresh will engage the sector through instruments as follows:

- Support to strengthen the Enabling Environment
- Financial Support Services
- Technical Assistance in Business Management and Agronomy
- Creating Avenues for Youth Employment
- Business Platforms, Roundtables and Events
- Trade Promotion

Overall, the program seeks to achieve a competitive and innovative high-value fruit and vegetable sector, and inclusive and sustainable growth of the fruit and vegetable sector and a conducive business climate.

About HortiFresh Fruit and Vegetable Fair

The Fruit and Vegetable Fair is an annual Event that provides a platform for trade promotion within the horticulture sector. This helps create market opportunities for these businesses and generate partnerships as well as sensitize the general public about horticulture sector activities.

The objectives of Green Label are couch to impact on Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 2, 3, 8 and 12.

To be certified as Green Label compliant, a farmer, or group of farmers must pick up an application form from the Green Label Ghana Secretariat, organize production systems to meet the requirements and document these in the requisite records kept on the production activities' and be audited by accredited auditors. The report of the audit will be submitted to the secretariat for approval by the Committee of Experts before a certificate is issued. These certified farms are subsequently linked to markets and distribution systems.
